Buying a new HVAC system can be a costly project, so you need to ensure that you get one that is worth the money. Here are some important factors to consider when buying a new HVAC system.

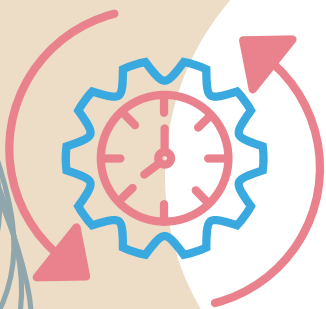
SIZE

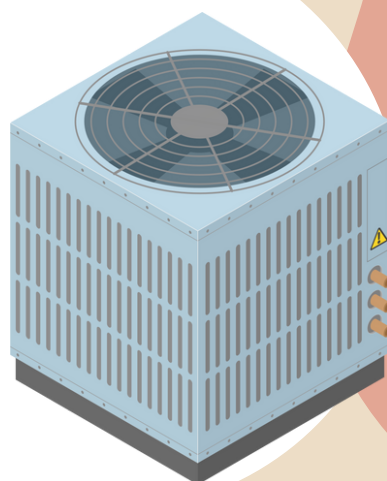
QUALITY
